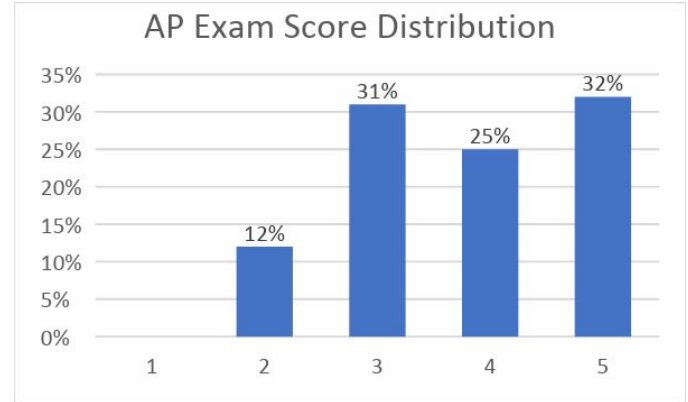
FSAPS offers 15 AP courses:
