# What are Academic Teams Middle & High School

Academic Teams compete in extracurricular competitions against other schools. They include:

- Math Olympiad
- Model UN

# What you should know:

- Most middle school and high school students will compete on at least one team
- Students can participate in a maximum of two teams. **Exception:** Students cannot do both Robotics and Math or Science Olympiad.
- Remember, a student cannot be on two teams that meet at the same time
- Students applying for an Academic Team must complete both the appropriate Academic Team application form and the Academic Team Preference Form.

# Your behavior matters . . .

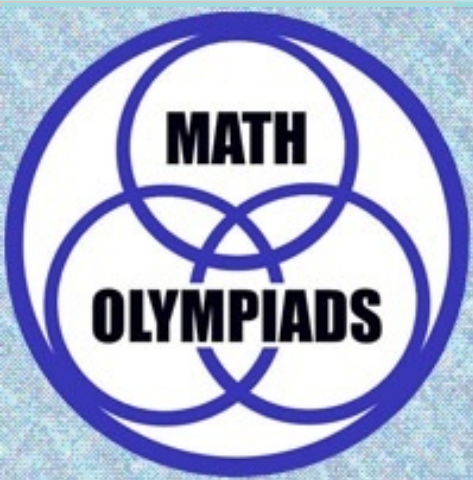
- All team members and parents must sign the **Academic Teams Policies & Procedures** .

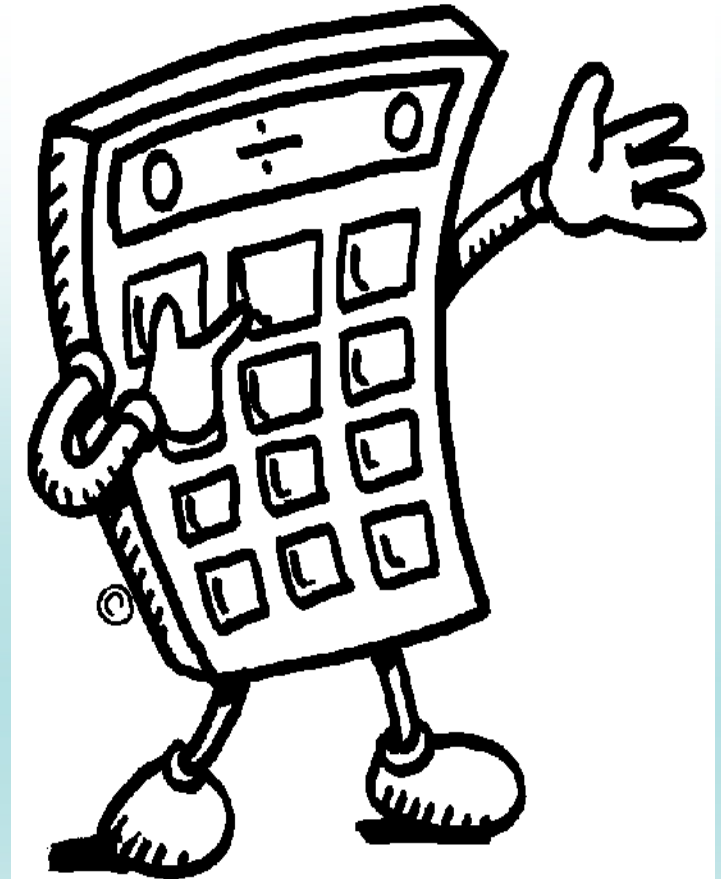

# What is Math Olympiad Team?

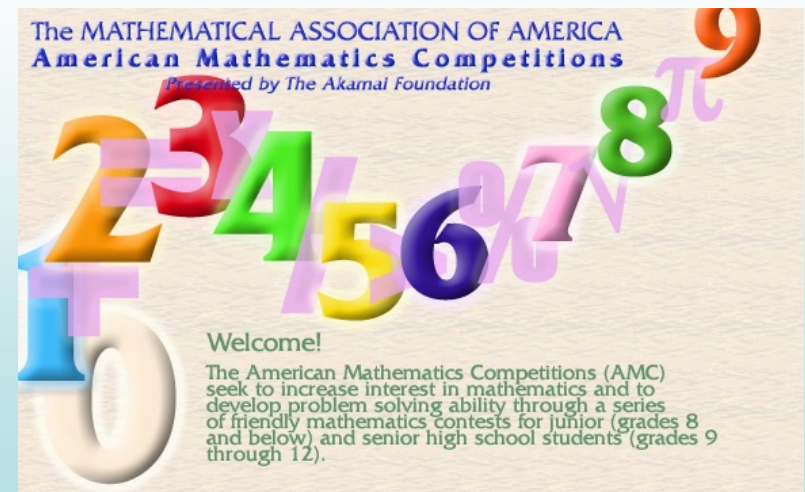
- Purpose

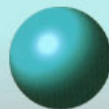

## And More .... 2018 & 2019 & 2020

To Count a few:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place as a team in State MATHCOUNTS **for the last five years**
- We had 3 students in top 4 of GA State MATHCOUNTS represented GA at Nationals in May 2019
- 1<sup>st</sup> place as a team at State High School Math Tournament for the last **two years in a row (2018 & 2019)** (was canceled due to pandemic in 2020)
- **Seven** of our students represented GA in 2019 National ARML High School Math Competition (was canceled due to pandemic in 2020)
- **Seven** members of FSA Math Team qualified to AIME in March 2019
- **Twelve** members of FSA Math Team qualified to AIME in March 2020
- 1st place as a team at Junior Varsity and Varsity Level at Rockdale Math Competition
- 1st place as a team at Junior Varsity level at North Fulton Math Tournament

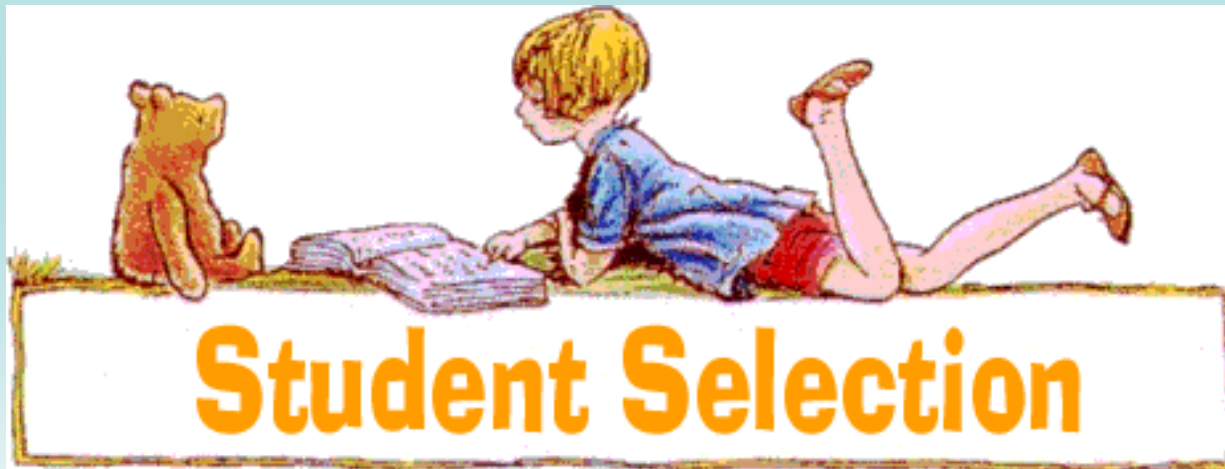
# Is this the right choice for me?
